UPDATE: A Different Light Bookstore in West Hollywood, CA

Hosting Author Joshua Dagon for Book Signing, Friday June 27, 2008

West Hollywood, California, 2008 – A Different Light Bookstore in West Hollywood, California will be hosting author Joshua Dagon for a reading and book signing of his third novel, *Into the Mouth of the Wolf* at 7pm, Friday June 27, 2008.

The author started writing *Into the Mouth of the Wolf* as an exploration on the idea of individual, government, and world reactions to the AIDS epidemic, using a contagion that turns people into werewolves as an analogy for the HIV virus. The story expanded into a commentary on many more issues, including: combating terrorism; facing and overcoming the fear of others; and individuals accepting as much personal responsibility as possible for their actions and the resulting consequences.

Into the Mouth of the Wolf was published and released April 2008 by Breur Media Corporation, which also published and released the author's previous novels, *The Fallen* (2006) and *Demon Tears* (2007). The two earlier novels comprise one story and are about a fallen angel and his circle of companions surviving in the Los Angeles circuit club scene. These books explore the concepts of personal and spiritual redemption, and strongly address the historic and present day successes and failings of organized religion.
